Each Doctor processes the patient's data, in particular health data, in compliance with medical confidentiality, the general regulations on data protection (Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC)("GDPR").

Patients enjoy their rights defined by the law of 22 August 2002 on the rights of the patient, in particular the right to a free choice of a Doctor, free and informed consent or information, which can be exercised in accordance with this law. You also have obligations as a patient:

- A patient who does not cancel a medical appointment in good time may be asked to pay a reasonable compensation to the doctor concerned, as set out above;
- The doctor has the right to claim fees for the mere drafting of a document concerning a patient's state of health (certificate, attestation, prescription, etc.), in the absence of any physical examination;
- The issuing of a document concerning a patient's state of health (certificate, attestation, prescription, etc.) may be charged as a consultation by the doctor when the patient is examined.
